### The Lottery

On Monday July 13, 2015 there appeared in the Winston-Salem Journal an article entitled: "Defrauding the Nation's Poor." As I read the article I was intrigued and pleasantly surprised to hear mentioned, among other things, the exploitation of the poor through state lotteries. Who is the main culprit in this arrangement? The State, of course -- The State sets it up and then gets its portion of the loot as the poor are being defrauded. But the State is not the only culprit. What about the businesses that are involved in this racket. They too are guilty. They are unequally yoked together with the State in this scheme.
