Paul tells us, "God is faithful, who will not suffer you to be tempted above that ye are able; but will with the temptation also make a way to escape, that ye may be able to bear it." (1 Corinthians 10:13) And in another place he wrote, "It is God which worketh in you both to will and to do of his good pleasure." (Philippians 2:13)


