The Perverted Gospel

The apostle Paul wrote these words to the church at Galatia, "I marvel that you are so soon removed from him that called you into the grace of Christ unto another gospel: which is not another; but there be some that trouble you, and would pervert the gospel of Christ." (Galatians 1:6-7)

What exactly is a perverted gospel? It is the gospel but with some man made changes. At Galatia they still believed in God. They still believed in Christ. In fact they believed much of the message of the gospel as preached by Paul. But they had added something else to it. They were incorporating some things from the law and making them a part of the gospel.

These additions to the gospel were totally unacceptable. As we said before, so say I now again, If any man preach any other gospel unto you than that ye have received, let him be accursed." (Galatians 1:8-9)

Let us all be warned. Never attempt to make any changes in the gospel.
