There are no big cars on the island and we only saw a hand full of good size trucks there. The narrow streets and sharp curves are too tight for 18 wheelers. We started looking around the Caribbean/Bahamas. We became friends with Sister Printence (the preachers wife at the Basseterre congregation) through facebook and we started asking questions about the work there. 
This picture does not do justice to island nation of St Kitts & Nevis or the city of Baseterre . One road goes all the way around the island and you could do this journey in about an hour and a half.




A 2 year old died from the flu while we were there

This expectant mother was due any day and we had the chance to gift her with a few baby items.



Getting to know the saints on Nevis




