The Great I AM

When recruited to lead the Israelites out of Egypt, Moses asked, "What shall I say to them?" Moses was hesitant about the task he had been given. He knew that he was about to stand before a nation of people and reveal some of God's great plan to save them from Egyptian bondage.

He feared rejection and anticipated questions. It was a plan that required an unseen God to demonstrate great power and authority before the oppressive Egyptians and a nation of Israelite slaves. Moses not only wanted to know what to say; he probably needed to answer the question for himself.

The Egyptians worshiped a host of false gods. The river, the birds, and the planets above all had a deity assigned to them. When either the Israelites or Pharoah asked, "Which God are you speaking of?" or "Which God has sent you?" how should Moses respond?
