Jerry Davis, Logan's grandfather, continues to decline and has stopped eating.

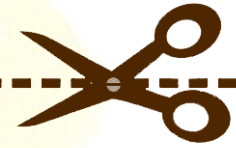
Matt Langfield continues to recover from covid.
