God Expects Our Best

God has always had expectations of His people. From the beginning, God expected men and women to obey His commands (Genesis 3:11). Under the Law of Moses, for those who lived during Old Testament times, God expected His laws of worship, cleansing, and sacrifice to be followed. Today He expects us to gather for worship on the first day of the week (Hebrews 10:24-25), to remember and proclaim His Son's death until He returns (Luke 22:19, 1 Corinthians 11:26), and to care for those who are in need (James 1:27), among many other commands.
