WHY SHOULD i CARE?

In His Sermon on the Mount, Jesus preached, "But seek first His kingdom and His righteousness, and all these things will be added to you" (Matthew 6:33). Coming from this reassuring passage of scripture, our theme for the year is "Caring for the Kingdom." Our elders have chosen this theme to remind us to care for and about His kingdom above everything else. But why should we care?

We should care about His kingdom so that God will care for us. If we focus on God, and the church, then "all these things will be added to you." God will take care of our needs if we "seek first His kingdom."

We should care about His kingdom to eliminate worry. Jesus' instruction before and after this verse is, "Do not worry" (Matthew 6:31, 34).
