AM I SELFLESS?

Selflessness is one of the greatest qualities that any
Christian can have and that every Christian needs. Am I
selfless?

A selfless Christian is more concerned with the needs
of others than with their own, and God commands this atti-
tude in His word. In Philippians 2, Paul writes, “Do nothing
from selfishness or empty conceit, but with humility of mind
regard one another as more important than yourselves; do
not merely look out for your own personal interests, but also
for the interests of others” (Philippians 2:3-4).

Selflessness is beneficial to the unity of the church.
What divisions could there be if every Christian was truly
selfless? Pride would never rule a men's meeting or elder-
ship, and harmful gossip would never be spoken.

Selflessness is helpful to the spiritual strength of the
members. If every Christian was more concerned with others
than themselves, how encouraged and uplifted would all of
us be? If we prayed for each other with the same regularity,
fervor, and sincerity as we might pray for our own needs,
members of the Lord's church would be spiritually stronger
than ever.

Selflessness is also perfectly demonstrated in the life
and death of Jesus. The Lord told His disciples, “Greater love
has no one than this, that one lay down his life for his
friends” (John 15:13). Not only did Jesus then command that
of His disciples, He perfectly and selflessly demonstrated it
on the cross.
