Behold the Lamb of God

What amazes you? There are many things that fascinate different people; engineering feats, breathtaking architecture, or even simple landscapes. Everywhere we look, there seems to be something capable of inspiring awe.

Now imagine being in the first century, standing on the banks of the Jordan River, listening to John preach repentance. He speaks of One who is coming after him. Someone far greater. Someone more worthy. As the crowds respond to his preaching, John suddenly declares, *“Behold, The Lamb of God who takes away the sin of the world”* (John 1:29). What kind of awe do you think those words inspired in the people who heard them? How many truly understood what John was saying in that moment?
