What Has Changed?

Look around at the world and consider how much has changed over the years. There was a time when morals, respect, and good behavior were expected to be taught in the home. Isaiah 5:20 warns that the Israelites lack of concern for the judgement day had caused many to change the idea of what is wrong to be right.

Perhaps a shift in priorities is needed. Before we can change others, we have to change ourselves, ensuring that we are not just putting on a show. Instead, be those who grow in Christ, and do not decline with society.
