Cuba

Thanks to all of you that help we were able to send funds for food and the church building project this year. We actually sent money 8 times before Western Union got shut down to Cuba. Then COVID-19 hit and although they did not have many cases in Cuba everything got shut down. Food was hard to come by...remember you get what the government gives you. There were not many essential workers there. Peter (the preacher in Colon) was able to walk to some of the farming areas to get food and shared with not only those in the church in Colon but others he knew about that were struggling. Currently there are NO missionary visa's being offered...so what does that mean for us? We could go this fall (when the Havana airport opens) BUT ...not teach. We could not travel in the Country in anything but a government approved

taxi, only stay in government approved housing. Most small hotels have given up their license so they don't have to pay taxes during this time. They are still very limited as to how much they can get out and do. I know here being confined has been challenging but can you imagine being confined behind these bars and that is your view everyday? We think we will have the opportunity to send some \$\$ to them again before the years out and go in the new year.

What's coming up? "The in and out, up and down of conducting a personal bible study" in a workshop environment . That means practicing what it takes to conduct these studies and the materials that can be used.

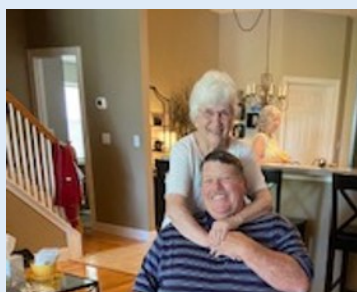
Class to start September 14th at 7pm in the fellowship room at N. Main
